## KOI CLASSIFICATION SERIES By: Rosimeri Tran

**Hikari Moyo** are any metallic koi that display two or more colors. Some examples of these are: *Hariwake, Kujaku, Kikokuryu, Hariwake Matsuba, Gin Bekko, Yamatoniski* just to name a few. They all will have a platinum background with a colored pattern that will be bright on top of the platinum. As you can see in the examples below, you can see that the background should be a bright platinum color, which will make the color pattern, pop out and really stand out to catch your attention.

Hariwake: A white metallic koi with either yellow or orange pattern, they can be scaled or Doitsu variety. Look for one that is a bright white background with a Kohaku pattern.



Yamato-nishiki: This is a metallic Sanke and is usually Doitsu. These should be held to the same standards of Sanke when purchasing, a bright white and crisp, bright even pattern. Bred by combining a Sanke and Platinum Ogon.



Kujaku: This is a white metallic koi with an red/ orange pattern, with a Matsuba netting pattern. The Hi pattern is judged like a Kohaku and should not overwhelm and cover up the white background.



It is with a sad heart that I have to report that on January 6, 2016 we lost a friend and formal CCKS member, Donald Robb or as club members knew him Don Robb. Don retired from the koi hobby a few years back but always made an appearance at our September koi show to check out the koi and say hello to everyone, and sometimes he might even show up at a club meeting hosted by the Garrison's.
